Dr. Emery Porter, of St. Luke's Hospital and a personal friend of Raymond Ostby from tennis-playing days at Brown University, finally convinced the brothers that Englehart was drowned when he explained he had visited every sick person on

The brothers called home with the sad news and the rest of the family took the midnight train from Providence to New York. The plan was made to spread out and check every single hospital and charitable group which had gathered-in *Titanic*

Helen related her story to her brother Raymond who released it to the the Journal as follows:
