Wife Gets Decree at Philadelphia--Both Titanic Survivors

PHILADELPHIA, June 15---Mrs. Lucille Polk Carter, daughter of Mrs. Stewart Polk of Baltimore, widely known in society circles in this city, Baltimore, Newport, and Washington, today obtained a divorce from William E. Carter. The court ordered the papers in the case impounded, and the charges were not made public. Mr. and Mrs. Carter and their two children are survivors of the Titanic disaster.

Mr. Carter is the son of William T. Carter. He is an ardent horseman and poloist.
